For what purposes do we process your data (purpose of processing)?

Events

Erlanger Tanzhaus e.V. engages you to participate in events. For the execution of the contractual agreements it is necessary to save your address as well as your bank account. In advance, we will draw attention to the event by means of suitable advertising measures (Flyer, "Tanzhaus Heft" (our program booklet), website). Tanzhaus documents the event through photo and film recordings and uses them for its own archive and for reporting on the event.

Website

On our homepage Erlanger-Tanzhaus.de and other platforms such as Facebook information about future and past events are provided. These include names and, on a voluntary basis, the contact details of dance instructors and artists.

On which legal basis do we process your data?

We process your data for the fulfillment of contractual obligations in the context of event organization and performance.

We process your voluntary information within the scope of your consent.

Based on a balance of interests to safeguard the legitimate interests of Erlanger Tanzhaus, we process personal data to ensure IT security and to document the club's history of Erlanger Tanzhaus.

Who gets your data from us?

Within Erlanger Tanzhaus, those members receive your data, which are entrusted with the above-mentioned activities.

In addition, the following organizations can receive your data:

- Commissioned processors (article 28 DS-GVO), especially for IT services, who process your data for us according to instructions and
- public bodies in the presence of a legal or regulatory obligation.

A transfer of your data to a third country (i.e. a country outside the EU) or an international organization does not take place.

How long do we save your data?

We process your data for the duration of our contractual agreement. In addition, we store publicly available contact information for the organization of future events. Reports and photos of the event are stored indefinitely for the documentation of the club's history.

In addition, we are subject to various retention obligations arising, inter alia, from the Civil Code (BGB), the Commercial Code (HGB) and the tax laws. The storage periods provided there are two to thirty years.

Your rights

Wenn Du glaubst, dass wir Deine Daten rechtswidrig nutzen, hast Du das Recht Dich bei der Aufsichtsbehörde zu **beschweren**.

You have the right to receive **information** about what information we have stored about you. If we have stored incorrect data, you have the right to **rectification**. If the data is no longer required, you have a right to request the **deletion** of this data.

If you give your **consent** to use your personal data, you can **revoke** this consent at any time without cause with effect for the future.

If you believe that we use your data unlawfully, you have the right to **complain** to the supervisory authority.

Is there an obligation for you to provide your data?

Du musst nur diejenigen personenbezogenen Daten bereitstellen, die im Rahmen unserer vertraglichen Vereinbarung erforderlich sind, d.h. alle Angaben auf der Künstler-Vereinbarung oder ähnlicher Verträge, sofern diese nicht als „freiwillig“ gekennzeichnet sind.

You only need to provide the personal information required under our contractual agreement, i.e. all information on the artist agreement or similar contracts, unless they are marked as "voluntary".

RIGHT TO OBJECT ACCORDING TO ART. 21 GDPR

You have the right to object at any time to the processing of personal data concerning you, which is based on a balance of interests.
